

# National, California, and CCOF Organic Statistics GET THE NUMBERS ON ORGANIC

Organic's rapid pace of growth continues across the United States as organic products become a household norm for 82% of families in the country. In 2016, the organic sector experienced 8.4% growth, and the organic marketplace is projected to continue growing as the demand for organic increases.

In California, organic producers are stepping up to the task of growing organic crops for the nation; Californian organic farmers and ranchers produce 38% of all organic commodities sold in the United States. As the leader in a flourishing sector of the economy, California is truly the capital of organic.

- 1,069,950 acres of organic farmland–21% of organic acreage in the United States<sup>1</sup>
- 4,875 certified organic operations<sup>2</sup>

  - » 2,592 certified for handling
  - » 12 certified for wild crops
- California produces<sup>1</sup>:
  - » 38% of all U.S. organic commodity sales
  - » 64% of U.S. organic vegetable sales
  - » 100% of U.S. organic almond sales
  - » 96% of U.S. organic strawberry sales
  - » 20% of U.S. organic milk sales
- Organic product sales in California totaled:
  - **»** \$12.84 billion in 2016 (\$9.94 billion in processed products and \$2.9 billion in organic agricultural commodities)<sup>1,4</sup>
